HOW YOUR MONEY HELPS

- **£5 a month** helps cover the medical check ups for a child at our school
- **£10 a month** helps provide hot meals for a child in one of our after-school programmes.
- **£27.50 a month** supports a child's education, school fees, books, uniform and transport to school.
- **£25.00 a month** supports a child's living and medical costs in our hostel.
- **£30.00 a month** helps support one of the children with disabilities attending our school and helps cover basic medical attention.

CHILD SPONSORSHIP

"In the communities we serve, many Indian families live on less than £1.50 per day. Education and medical care come at a cost that many cannot afford as they struggle to just feed their families and are often crippled by debt"

At Hope Gardens we run an educational sponsorship programmes for children living in communities that Hope Gardens serves. We support families by covering all education fees, uniform costs and transport fees enabling children to attend school.

Hope Gardens also runs a hostel for children in the beautiful Rhema Gardens. Children live in a safe homely environment and take the bus to school each day with their friends. We care for 30 children in our hostel supporting orphaned children and children who have challenging family lives and need support.



£27.50 per month covers the education costs and transport fees for students



£25.00 per month supports the living costs of each child in our hostel in the Rhema Gardens

CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES

"In Indian society, those with learning disabilities are often neglected or abused and perceived as a burden or nuisance within the community. Our school supports children and their families "

In our tranquil coconut grove, we run a school providing tailor made education programmes. We love and care for these vulnerable and often unwanted children, teaching them basic life skills and how to integrate into society.

Our SEN (Special Educational Needs) school has recently been named number one school in the Theni District! Our free school bus service makes this educational opportunity accessible for all.



£30.00 per month supports the educational and medical costs for each child at our school

AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS

"Parents work long hours and are not getting home until late, many don't have enough money for food. Children are left after school to their own devices. Our after-school programmes ensure children don't go to sleep on an empty stomach"

We run 7 after school / tuition centres, 3 of which offer hot meals for the children. Every day, over 180 children join our teams to play games together, be supported with homework and enjoy snacks and often a hot meal. Some children prefer to stay until 9pm doing school work as they have no electricity at home or while they wait for their parents to return home. We have identified several communities in great need and want to reach out to more children by setting up new programmes as well as offering more frequent hot meals at our existing programmes.



After school clubs cost **£500** a month to feed and tutor approximately 30 children 5 days a week.



Any additional funds enable hot meals to be provided more regularly
